Fairfax County is currently updating our current Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Fairfax County Police Department and the Fairfax County Public Schools. This MOU defines the assignment and roles of School Resource Officers (SRO) who serve in our high schools and middle schools.

To enhance the process for updating the MOU, the *SRO Community Review Committee* will review the current MOU, consider proposed staff changes and provide perspective and feedback to be used for a final draft of the MOU that will ultimately be presented to the School Board and to the Board of Supervisors for approval.

The Committee will be chaired by Shirley Ginwright, chair of the Fairfax County Communities of Trust Committee.

The SRO Community Review Committee will be comprised of individuals representing FCPS and Community-based organizations with interests in ensuring a safe and respectful learning environment within our Schools.
